- GBDG is run on organic principles, using organic growing mediums and where possible organic seed.
- We have an emphasis on planting native species to increase bio-diversity on site.
- We aim to reduce waste by reusing and composting organic materials, recycling plastics where possible. No peat based products are used within our work
- We practice and encourage low- energy skills including scything, coppicing, seed saving, willow crafts. We also make and sell some of our own products at the local market.
- We aim to source local and sustainable materials and resources
- Where possible we try to protect existing wildlife habitats and also create new ones.
- GBDG does not use mains water but a limited amount of natural supply from the stream to establish new plantings. Generally, we aim not to water but to improve soil retention through no-dig practices such as mulching.
